Recreational Fees

All fees are non refundable. It is required that all Strutters have a credit card on their STS accounts. Statements will be emailed every Friday if you have a balance on your account. All accounts must be current to participate in any

Tuition

- Tuition is due on the 5th of each month.
- Annual membership fee \$50.00 charged at initial registration
- •Tuition –\$55.00 monthly (for a weekly 45 min-I hour class)
 •After your first I hour weekly class, additional classes are I/2 price
- Tuition is based on a monthly schedule of classes

Tuition Late Fee

- All credit cards on Strutter accounts will be ran on the 5th of every month.
- If your account is past due on the 6th of the month, a \$15 non paymnet fee will be charged to your account & class suspension will be in effect until a response with a
- payment date is received.

 If payment has not been made to your credit card will automatically be processed on the 10th and 15th until payment is received.
 (a \$15 non payment fee will be applied per declined transaction)
- All accounts not current on the 16th of every month will become inactive. All inactive students will be dropped from all registered classes and required to re-register.

Other Fees

- A \$30.00 charge on all returned checks.
- A \$1.00 charge for over the phone parent portal assistance.
 A \$1.00 per minute charge for early drop off or late pick up fee.
- Recital Costumes \$65 per costume. Total cost will be divided into 3 equal payments charged in Dec, Jan, and Feb.
- Optional Private Lessons: \$40.00 an hour for I student (plus \$10.00 for each additional student-5 students max)

- Siblings of the same household receive a 10% family discount on monthly tuition
- 25% off most merchandise in Dance Showcase and the online Strutter Store. (August ONLY)

- There are optional fundraisers to help defray the expenses of dance.
- •90% of fundraiser profits (40% of total sales) will be applied to the Strutter's account.

The recreational season begins the day after Labor Day and runs through the annual recital.

Attendance Policy

All Strutters are strongly encouraged to attend all practices, performances, and other events. Each student is valued and must be counted on to be present at all times. We understand there will be times you will miss class, please notify us if this happens. Multiple absences may result in a private lesson at the discretion of the instructor. All Strutters are encouraged to practice independently outside of regularly scheduled practice times. Choreography for Christmas Show and Annual Recital can be found on our website. Private lessons are available (at an additional cost).

Classroom Dress Code

Any form-fitting dance top and dance bottoms are preferred. Strutters are welcome to express themselves with colors and styles! Tee shirts and denim bottoms are not acceptable dance wear. Hair must be pulled up, back and away from the face. Socks are not acceptable dance shoes.

Tutu Tumble

This class offers young children an introduction to the fundamentals of tumbling that will provide the building blocks necessary for their potential development in dance and overall fitness. By learning the benefits of flexibility, balance, strength, and body control inherent in all aspects of tumbling, your child will be better equipped to safely enjoy and excel in all of his or her future athletic endeavors.

Strutter Behavior

In order to run a productive class each student must display good behavior while at the studio or representing the studio at any outside event. All students are expected to follow the instructor's directions at the first request. Respect must be shown to all: classmates, instructors, parents, etc. When a student does not meet these expectations, they will be asked to leave the classroom until they feel they can correct the issue at hand. If a student is asked to leave the classroom more than once during a class period, they will be asked to call a parent and leave for the day.

Strutter Parent/Guest Behavior

If a guest is disruptive or disrespectful to a staff member, student, fellow Strutter parent, or other patrons at any event attended by South Texas Strutters, they will be asked to leave the event.

Both STS Parents and Students are required to keep all social media concerning Strutters positive. Failure to do so could result in dismissal from class.
